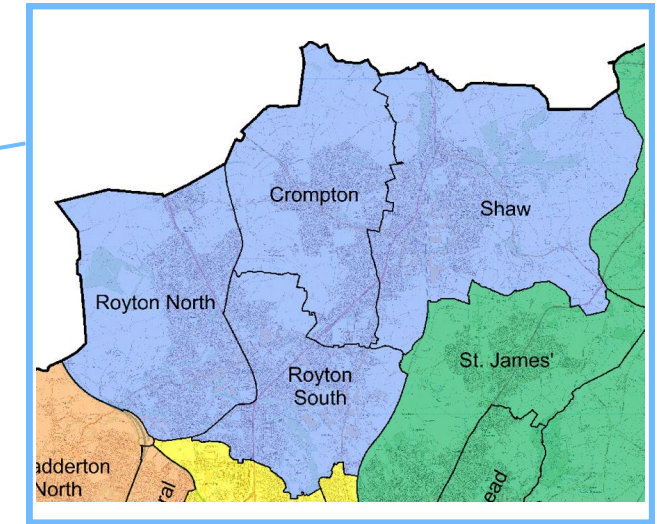
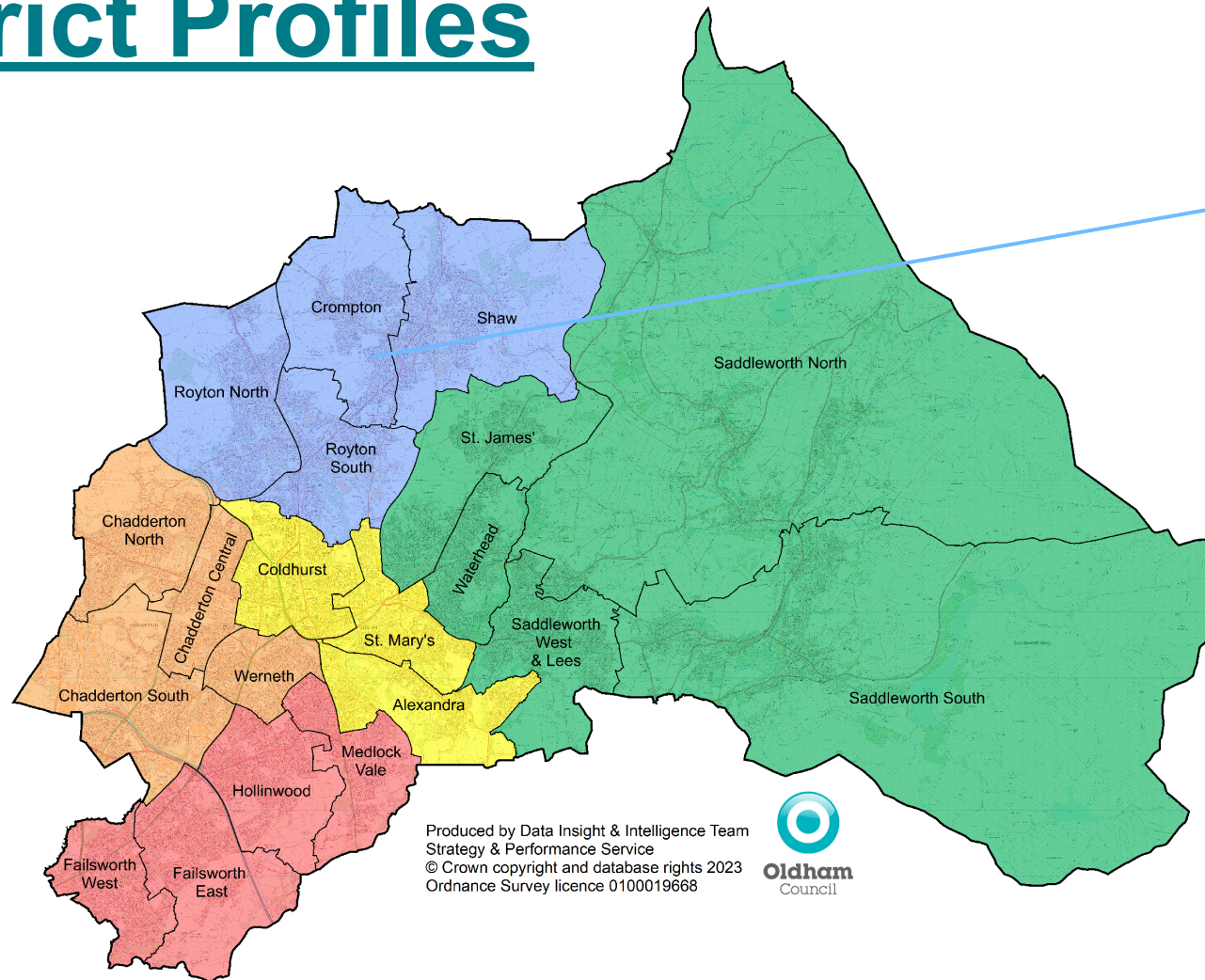

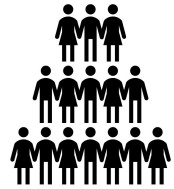


District Summary

- North District has the smallest **population** across Oldham. It is the only district within Oldham to see a decline in the number of residents between 2011 and 2021. The population is the oldest across the borough, with the lowest proportion of residents under 18 and the highest proportion of residents aged 65+.
- North has the lowest proportion of residents from a non-White British **ethnic background**.
- **Deprivation** levels are low across the district. No wards have a deprivation score higher than the Oldham average.
- The **median house price** is similar to the Oldham average in Royton South and Shaw and exceeds the Oldham average in Crompton and Royton North.
- **Socially rented homes** represent a smaller percentage of homes compared with the Oldham average and the proportion of **owner-occupied homes** is above average.
- **Unemployment and Youth Unemployment rates** are lowest across Oldham. All wards in North have a **median household income** higher than the Oldham average.
- Pupils in North have good **learning outcomes**, with rates above the Oldham average at all Key Stages, although only exceeding national rates in Key Stage 1. North sees the lowest percentage of school absences.
- **Life Expectancy** is higher than the Oldham average for both males and females.
- North has high rates of **Smoking, Diabetes, Depression** and **Obesity** and particularly high rates of **Learning Disability**.
- **Adult Mental Health Referrals and Contacts** are lowest across Oldham. However, the district has the highest levels for **Children's Mental Health** service use. It's important to note this doesn't necessarily reflect the prevalence within the population.
- North has the highest rate of **999 ambulance calls** and the lowest percentage of calls falling into the most urgent need category.
- North District has the lowest rate of both **Children's Social Care** activity and referrals. The district sees the highest proportion of its referrals from Health. **Adult Social Care** activity and referrals (age-standardised) are relatively low.
- The **crime rate** in the district is second lowest across Oldham. Shaw experiences a much higher rate than other North District wards.

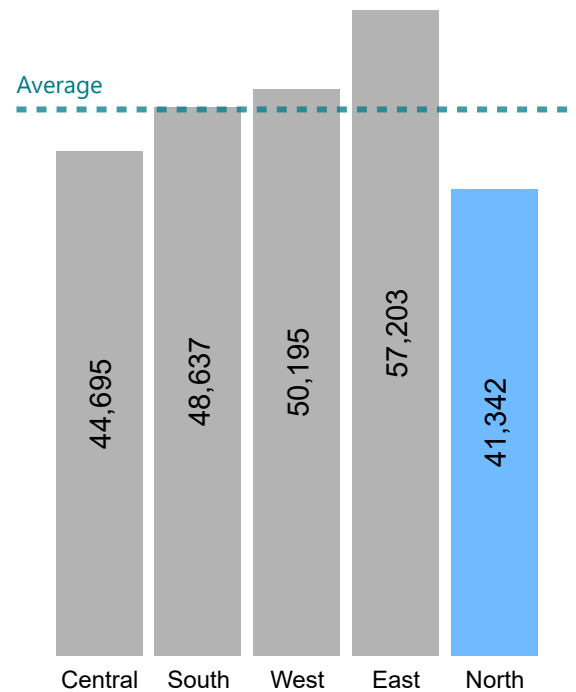

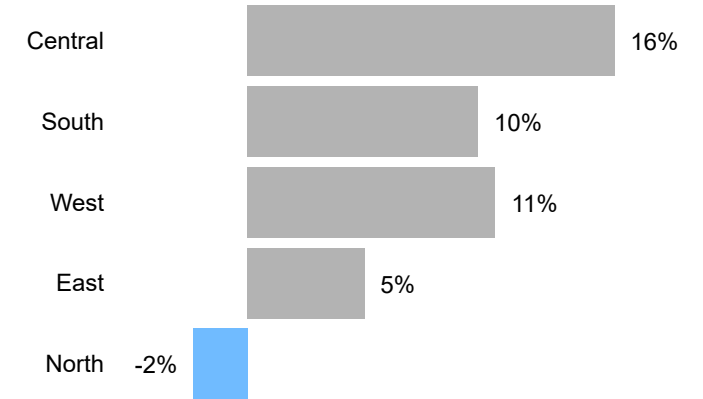
The **North's District's** population is the only district to be decreasing in population size.



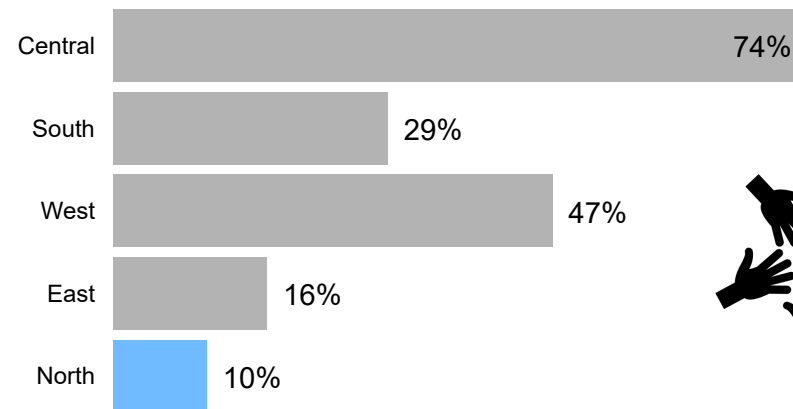
Whilst Oldham's population as a whole grew by 7.7% between 2011 and 2021, North's population shrunk by 2%.

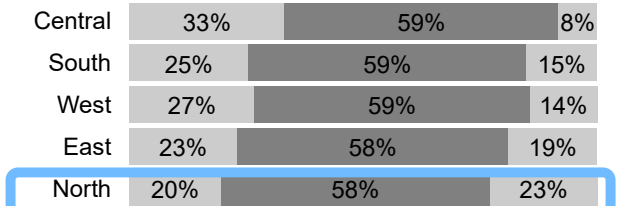

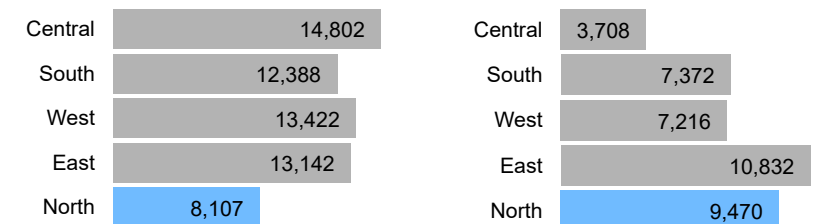
Age Profile

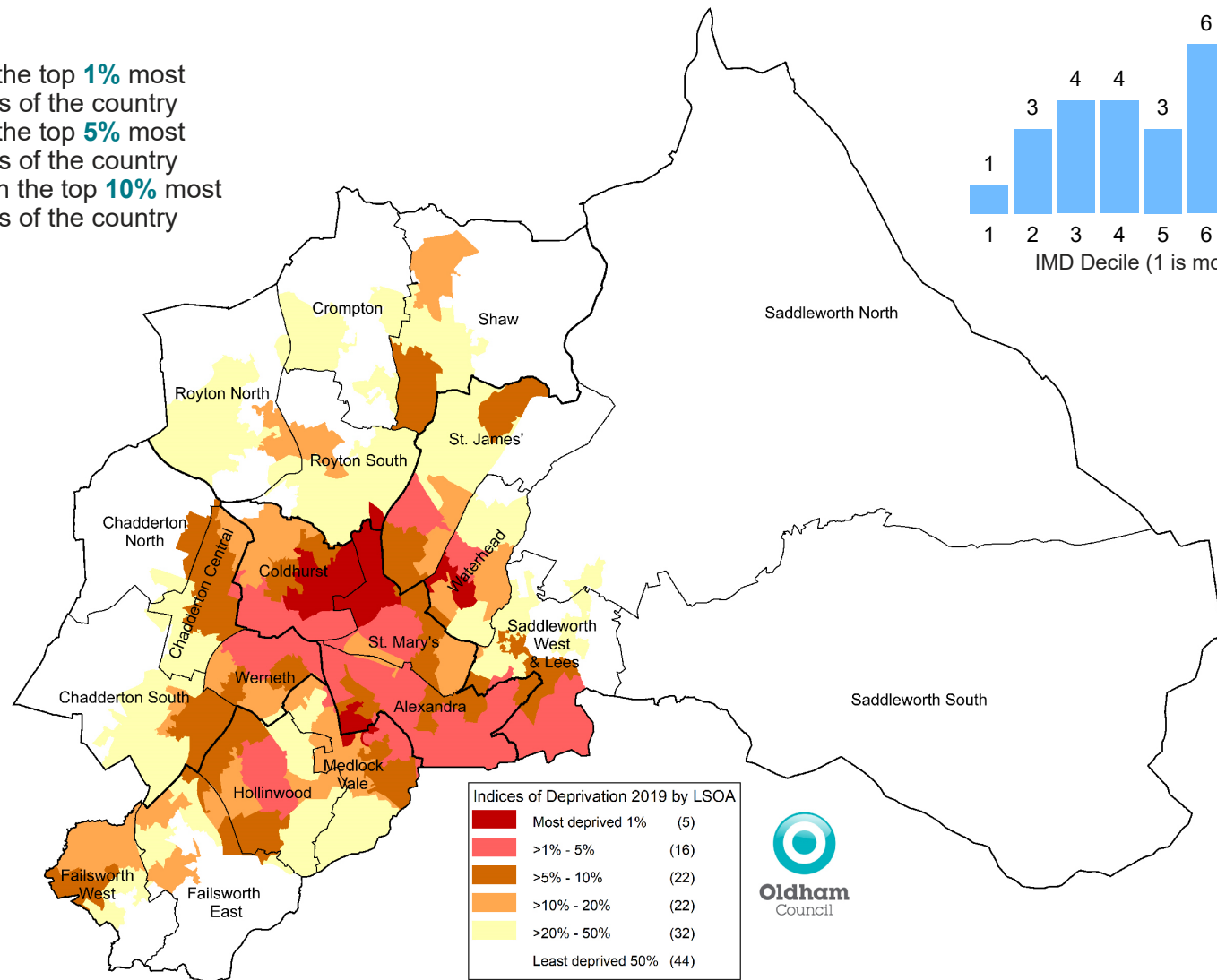

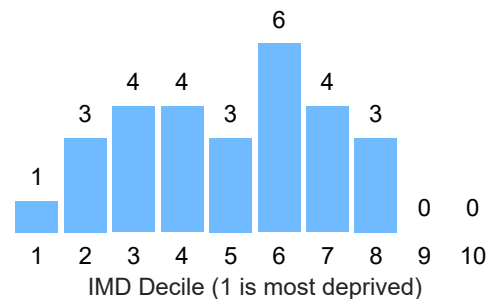

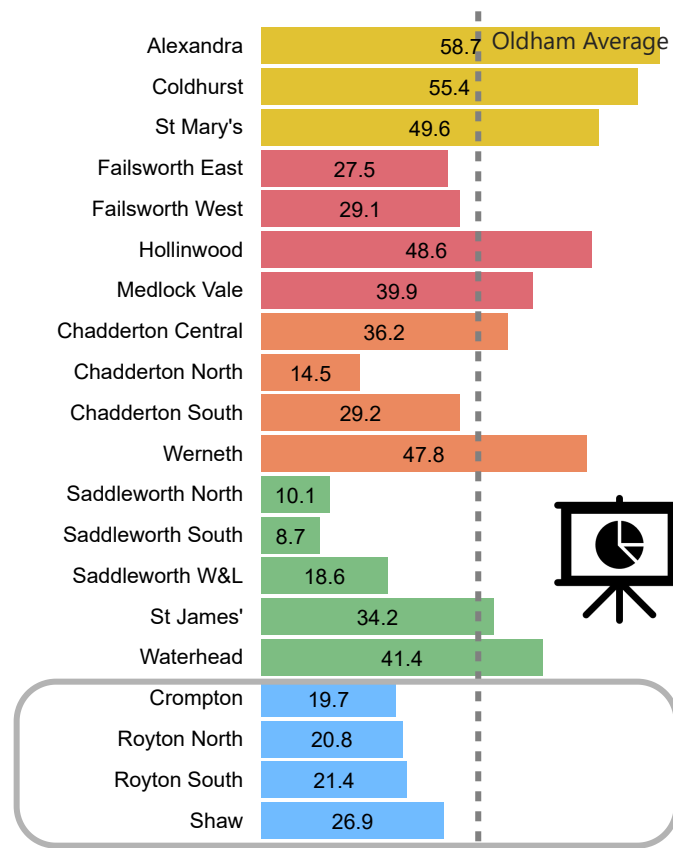

Average IMD Score

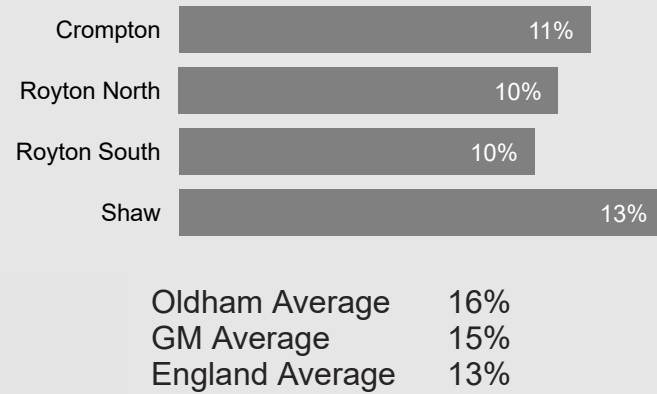

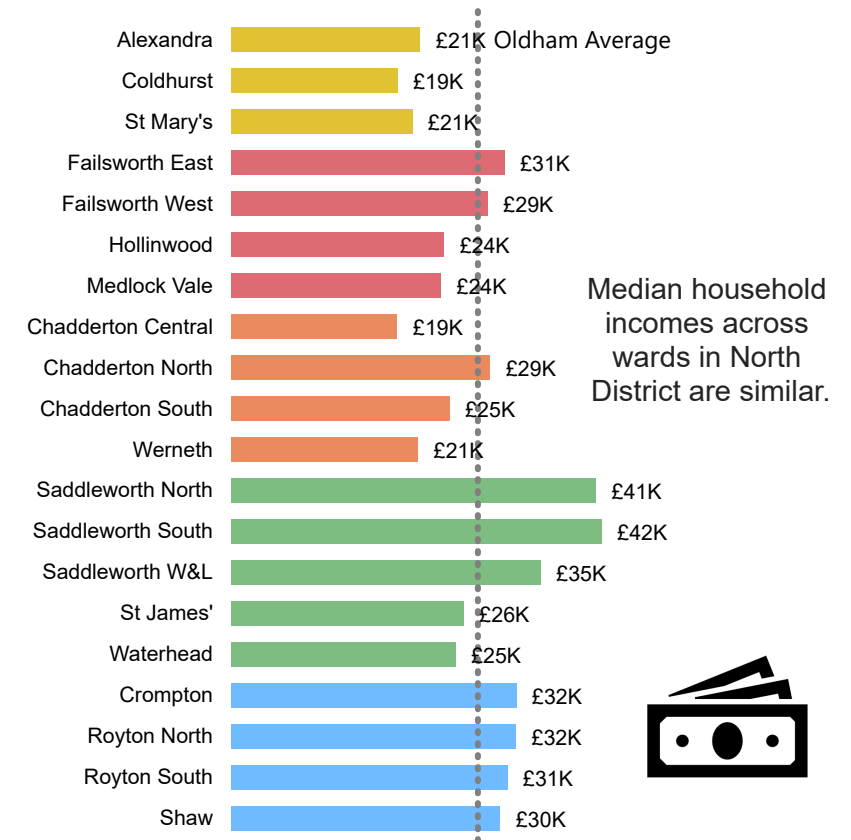
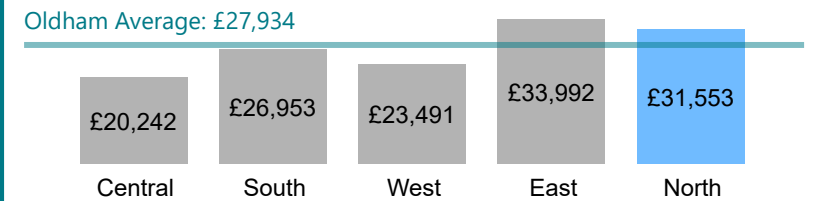
Youth Unemployment Rate

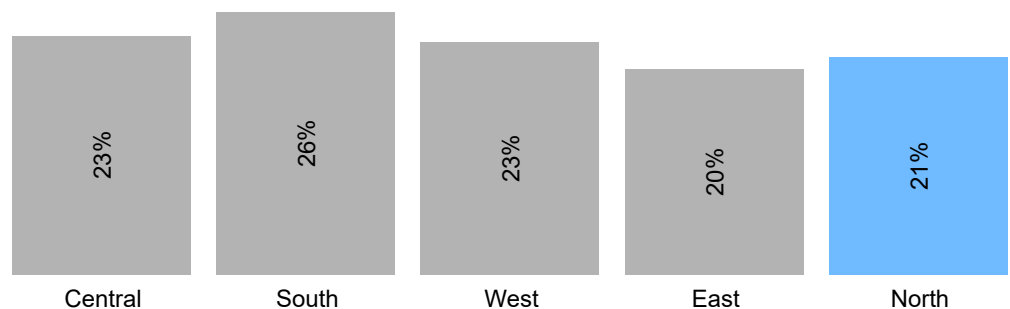

The rate across **England is 22%**.

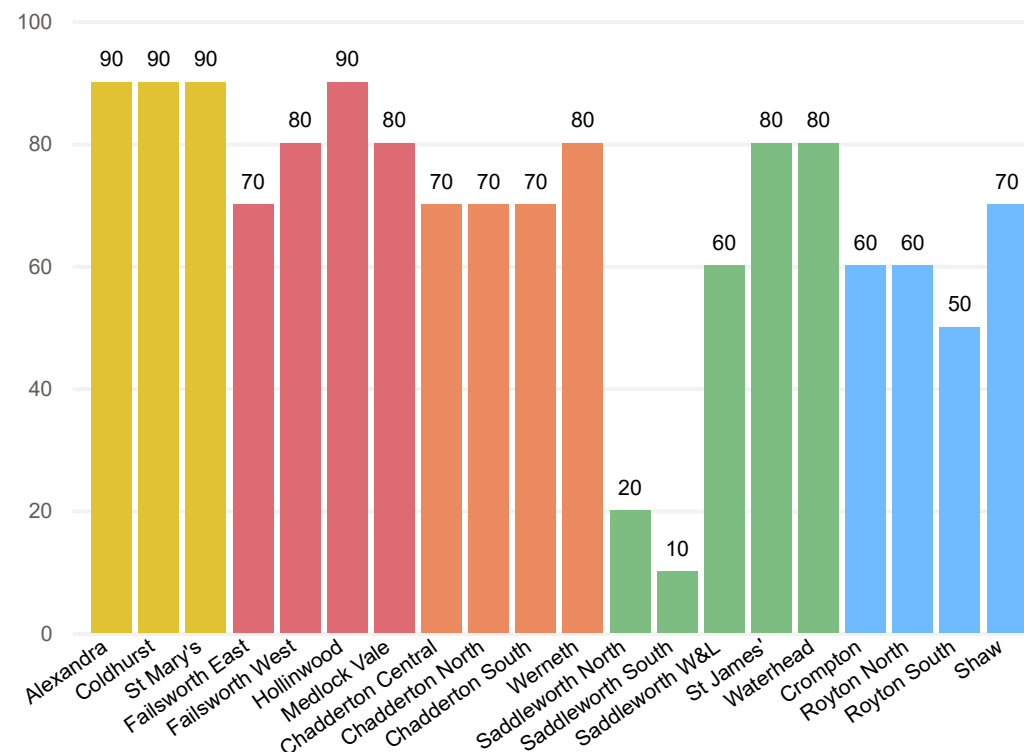


Child Poverty (IDACI)

IDACI (Income Deprivation Affecting Children Index) measures the proportion of all children aged 0 – 15 living in income deprived families.



The graph below is split into deciles, with a higher score being a more deprived area. A score of 10 means that ward is one of the 10% least deprived wards in the country. A score of 100 would mean that ward is one of the 10% most deprived wards in the country. A score of 90 means that ward is one of the 10 - 20% most deprived wards in the country.

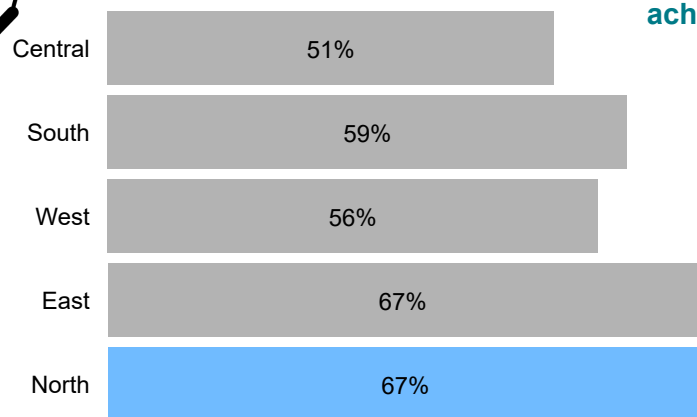


Good Level of Development by the end of Reception (GLD)

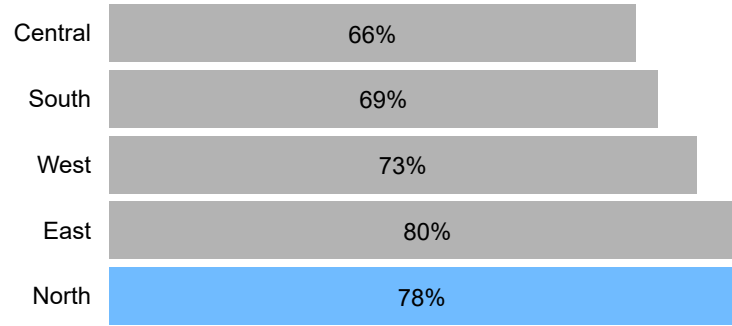

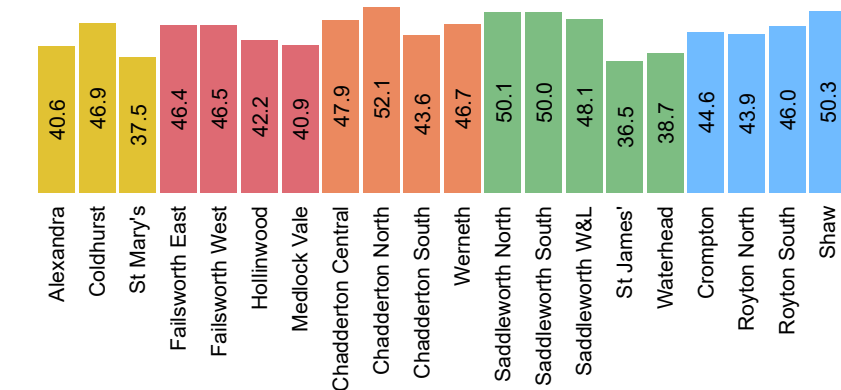

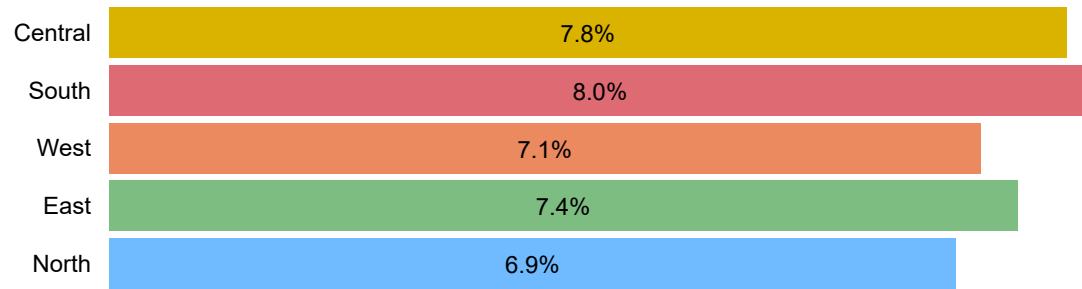

Percentage of school sessions missed for absence (2021/22)

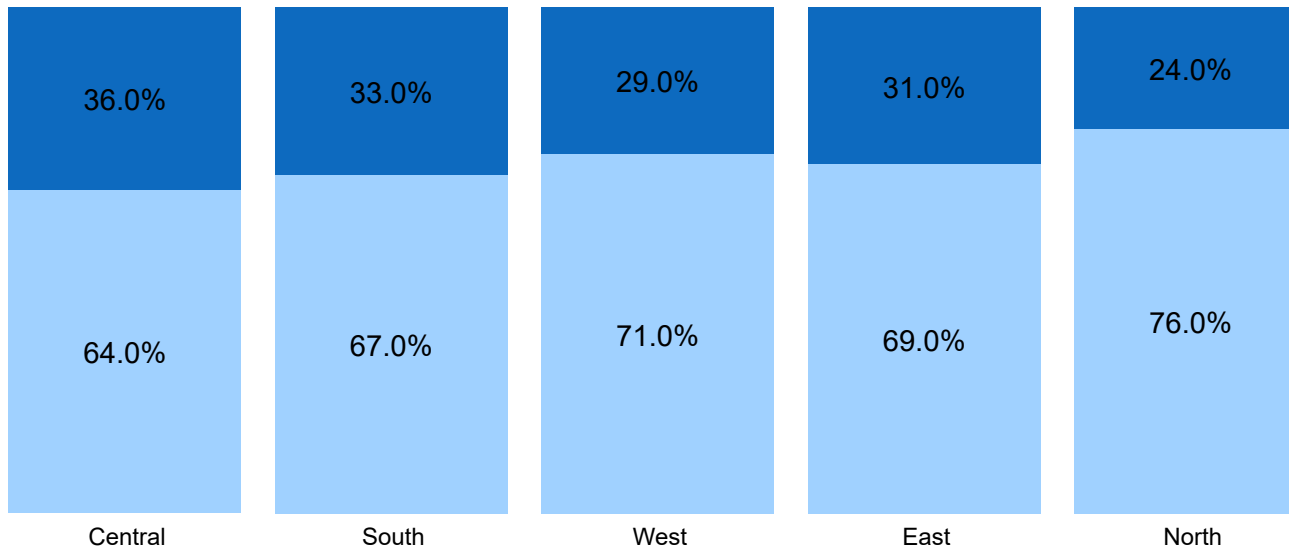

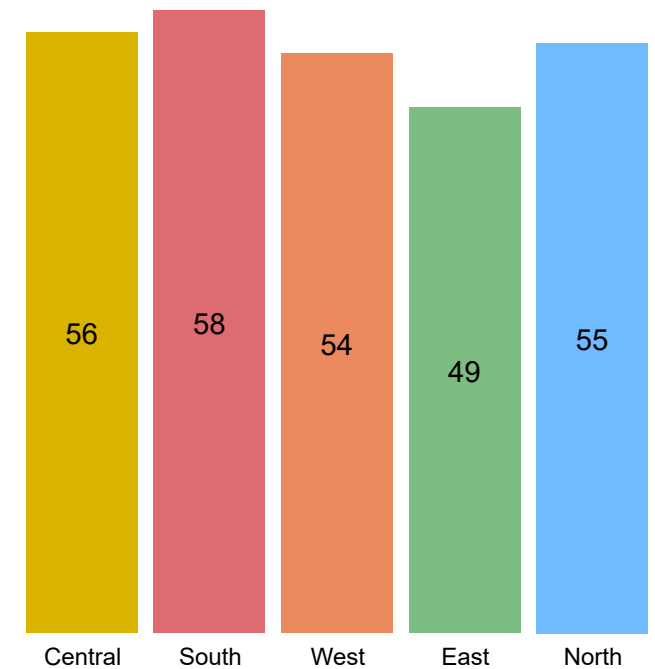
Percentage of authorised and unauthorised school absences (2021/22)

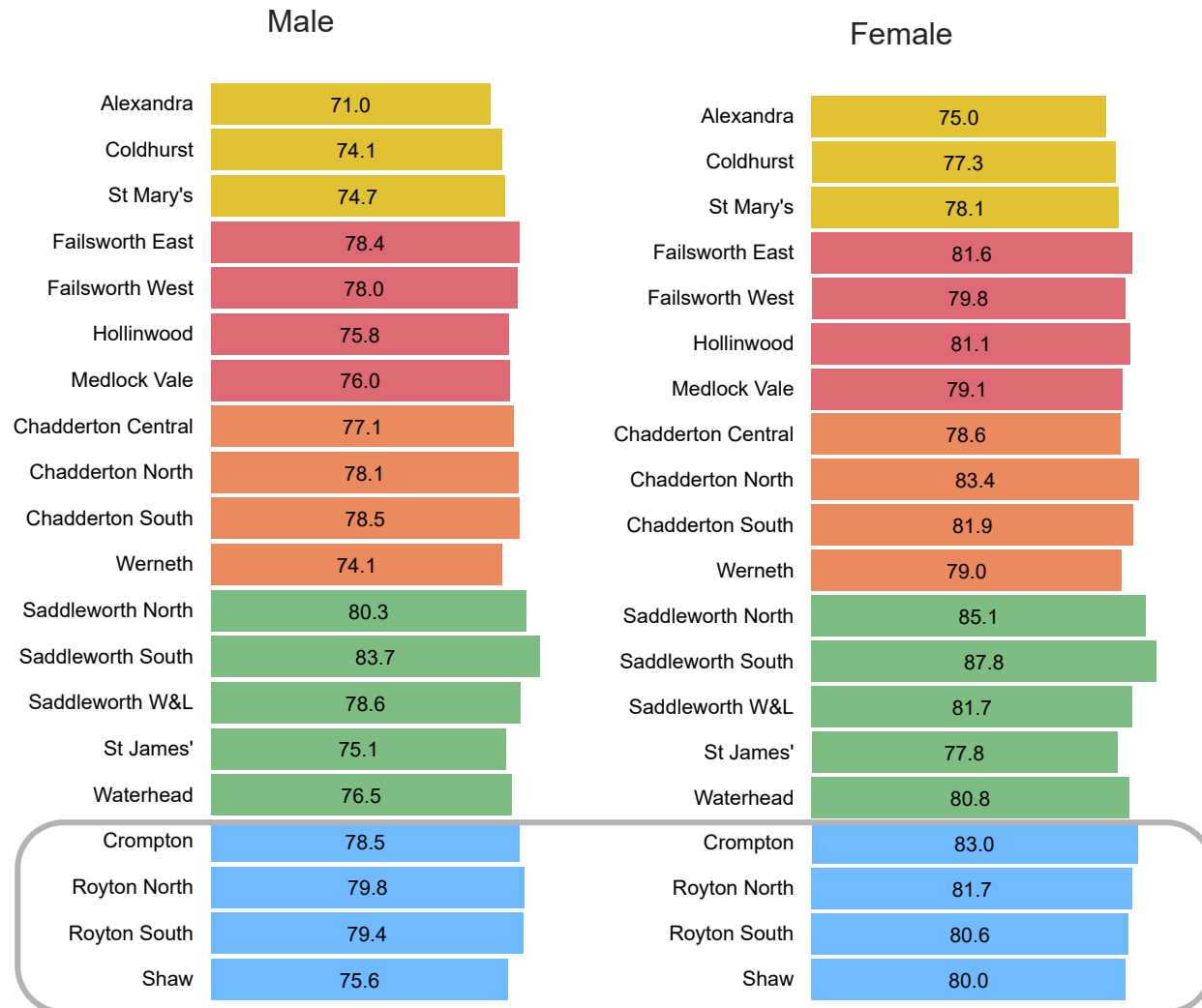

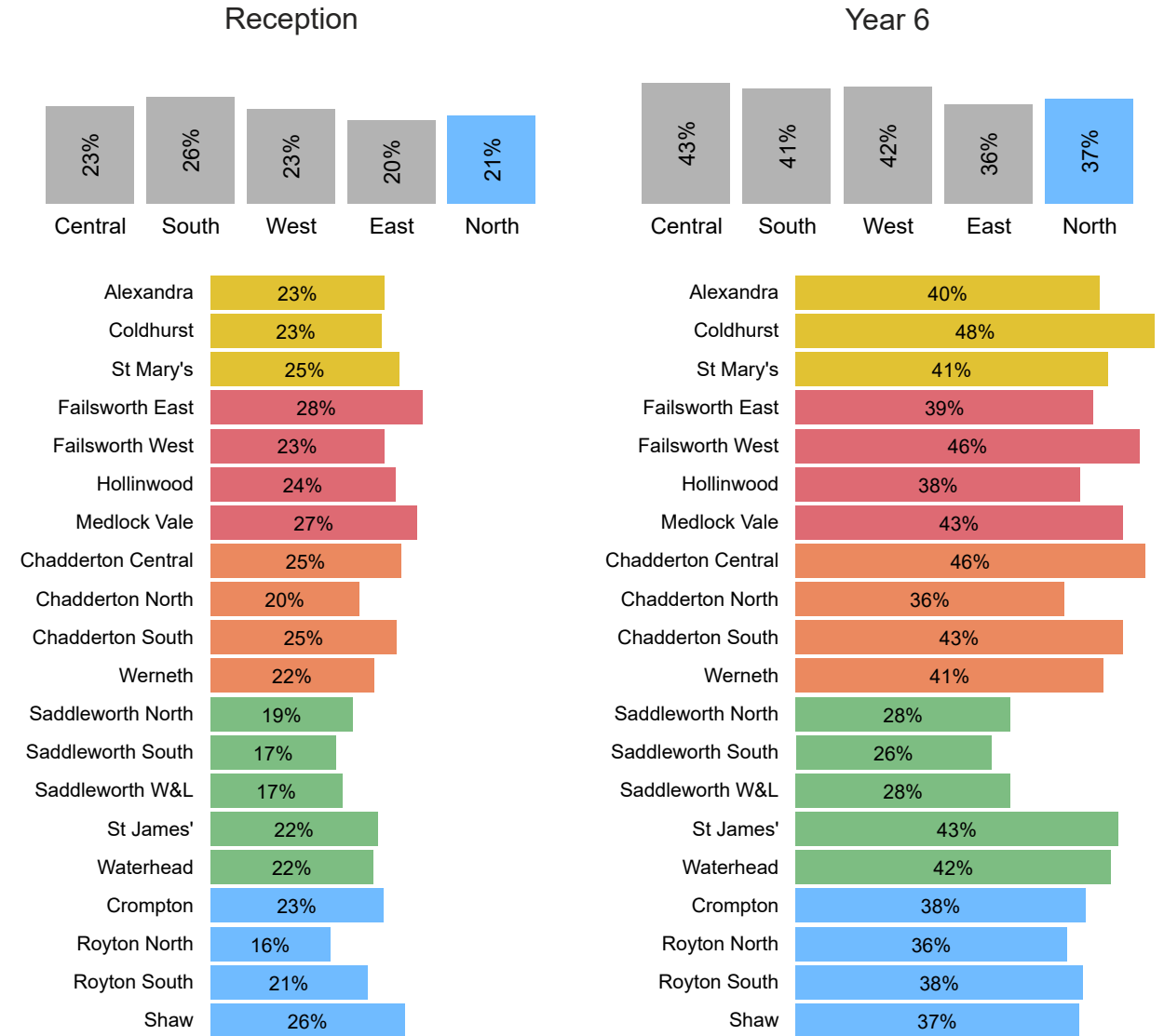


Life Expectancy at Birth (Years)

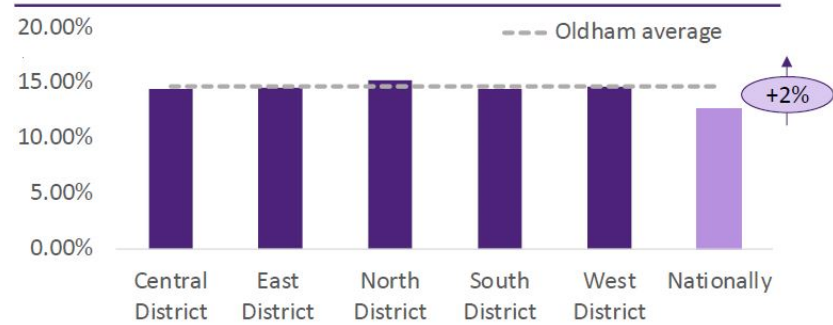

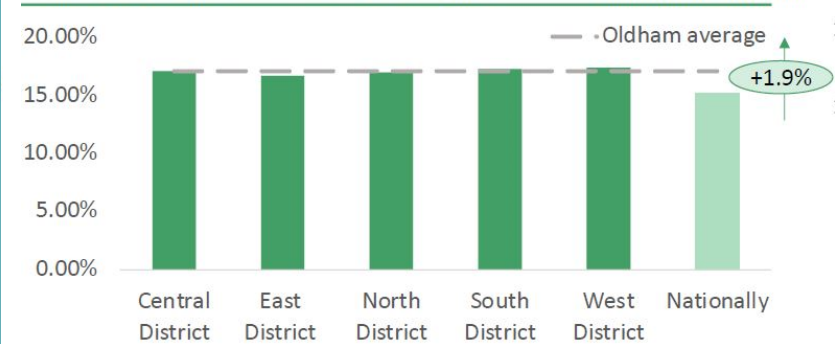

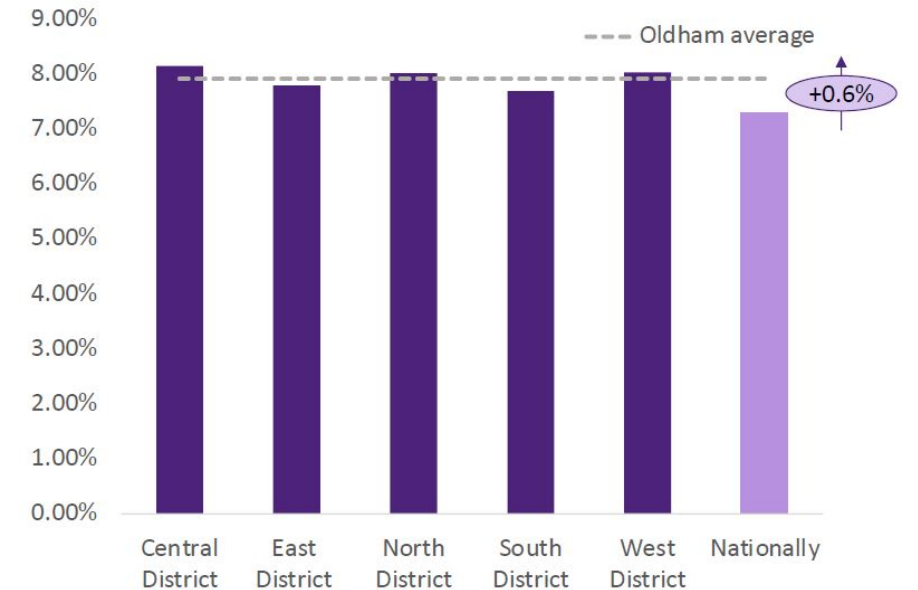

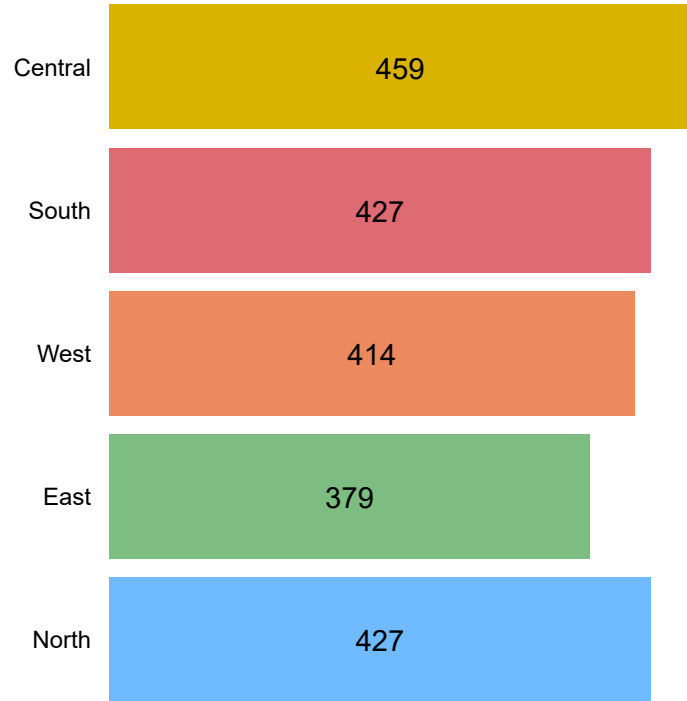
Diabetes mellitus prevalence - Type 1 and Type 2

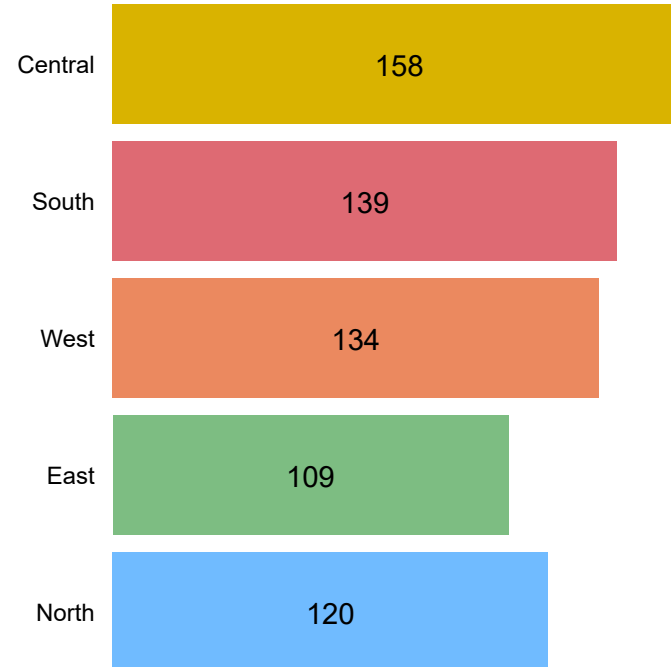

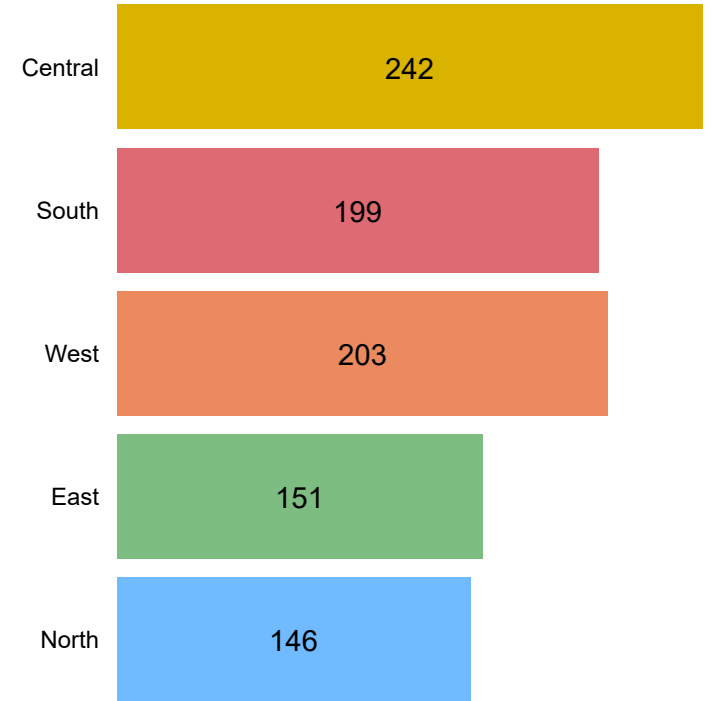

Elective Spells per 1,000, age-standardised (2022/23)

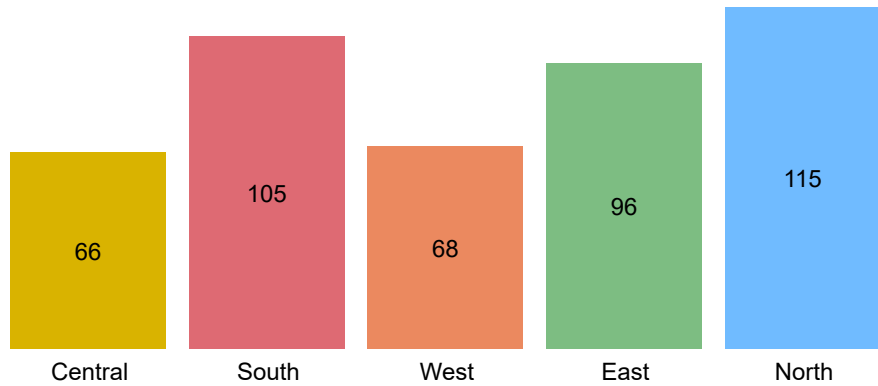

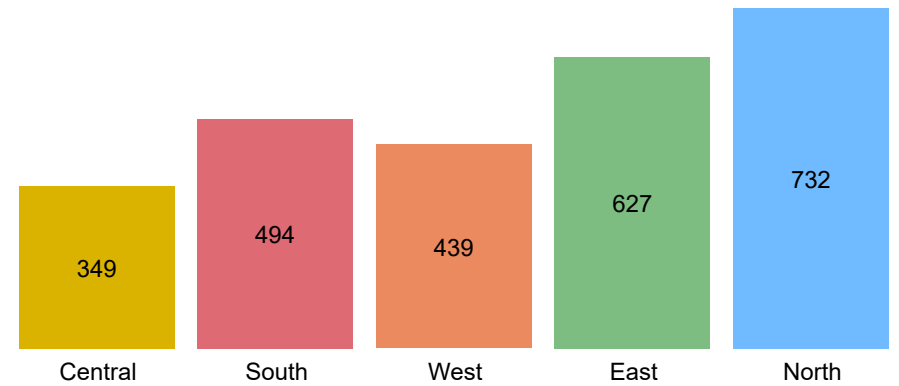

Children & Young People (0-18) Mental Health Referrals per 1,000 (2022/23)

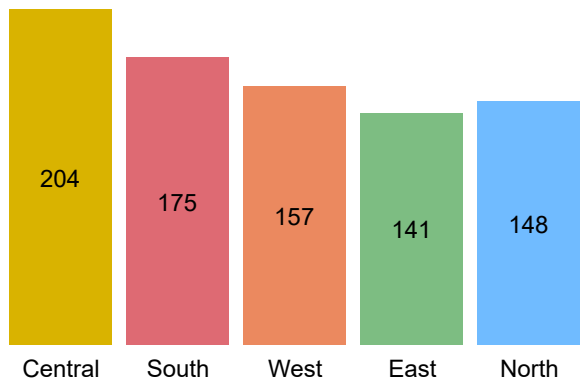

Children & Young People (0-18) Mental Health Contacts per 1,000 (2022/23)

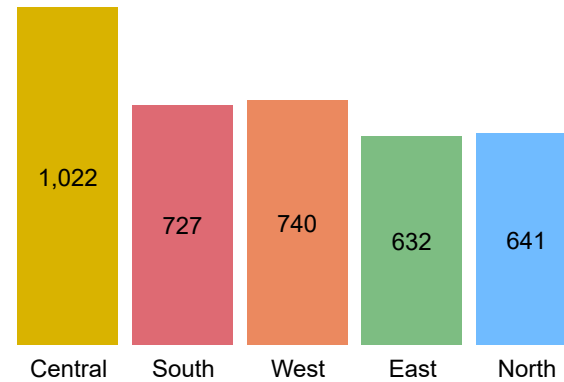


Adult Mental Health Referrals per 1,000 (2022/23)

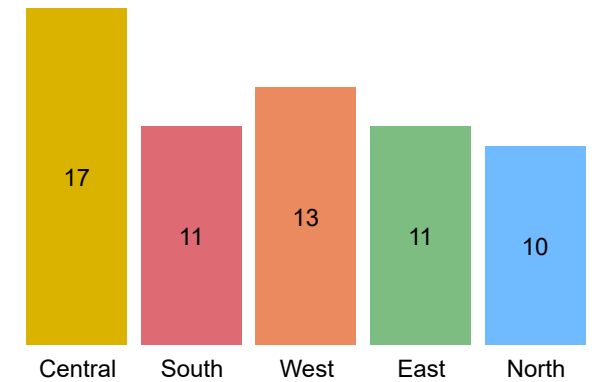
Adult Mental Health Contacts per 1,000 (2022/23)

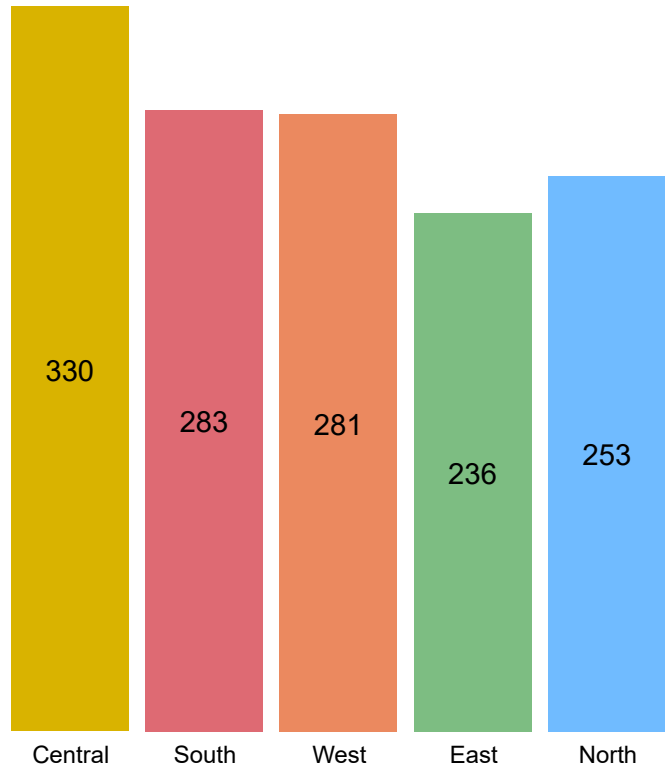


A&E Mental Health Attendances per 1,000 (2022/23)

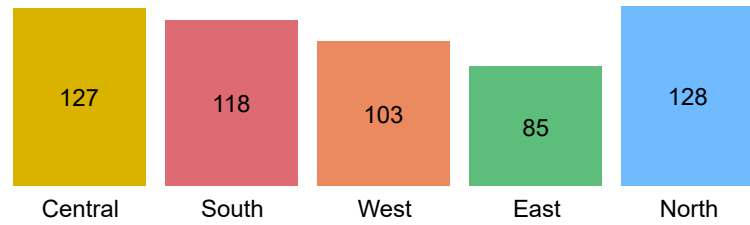

Number of 999 calls per 1,000 residents (2022/23)

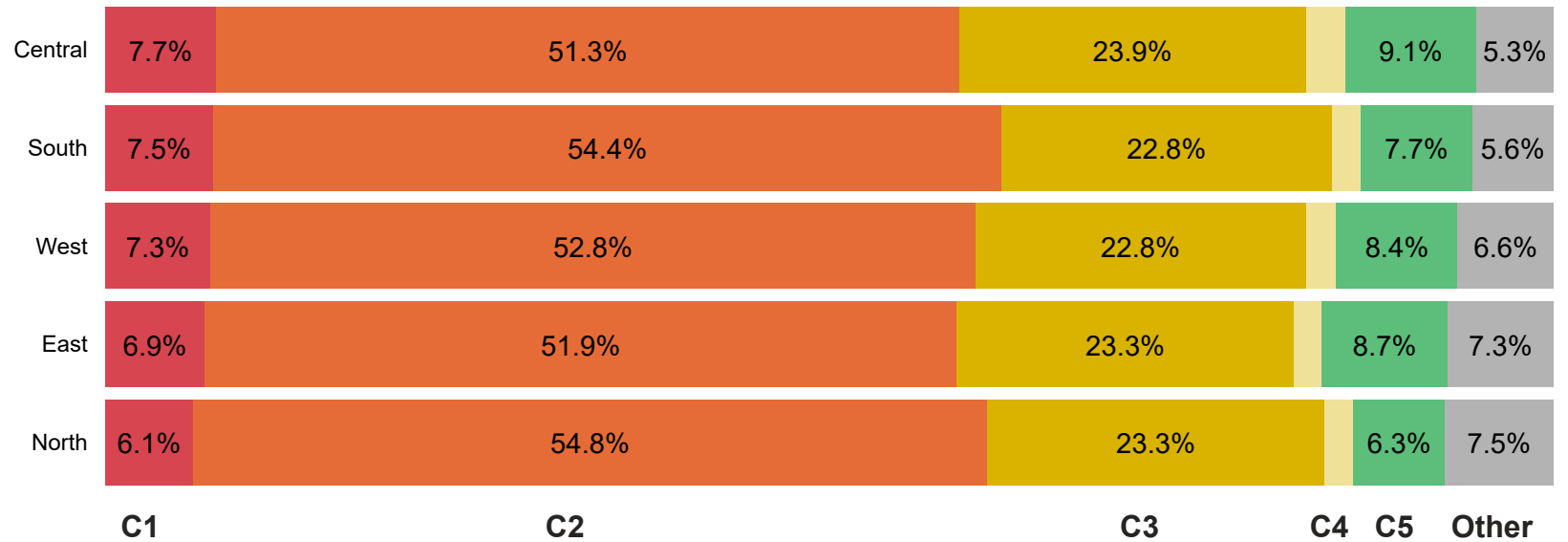

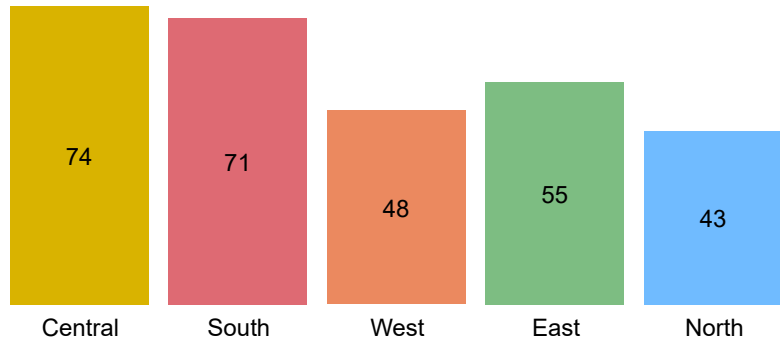
Distribution of ambulance calls by category (2022/23)

Category of call (C1 is most urgent) ● C1 ● C2 ● C3 ● C4 ● C5 ● Other

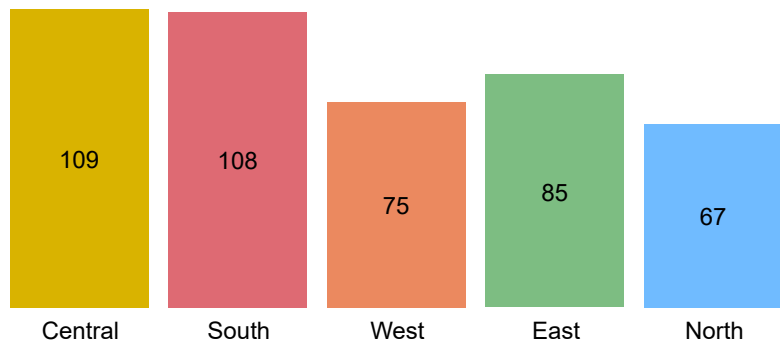

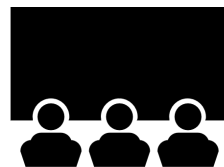
Children & Young People Social Care Activity per 1,000 (2022/23)



Children & Young People Social Care Referrals per 1,000 (2022/23)

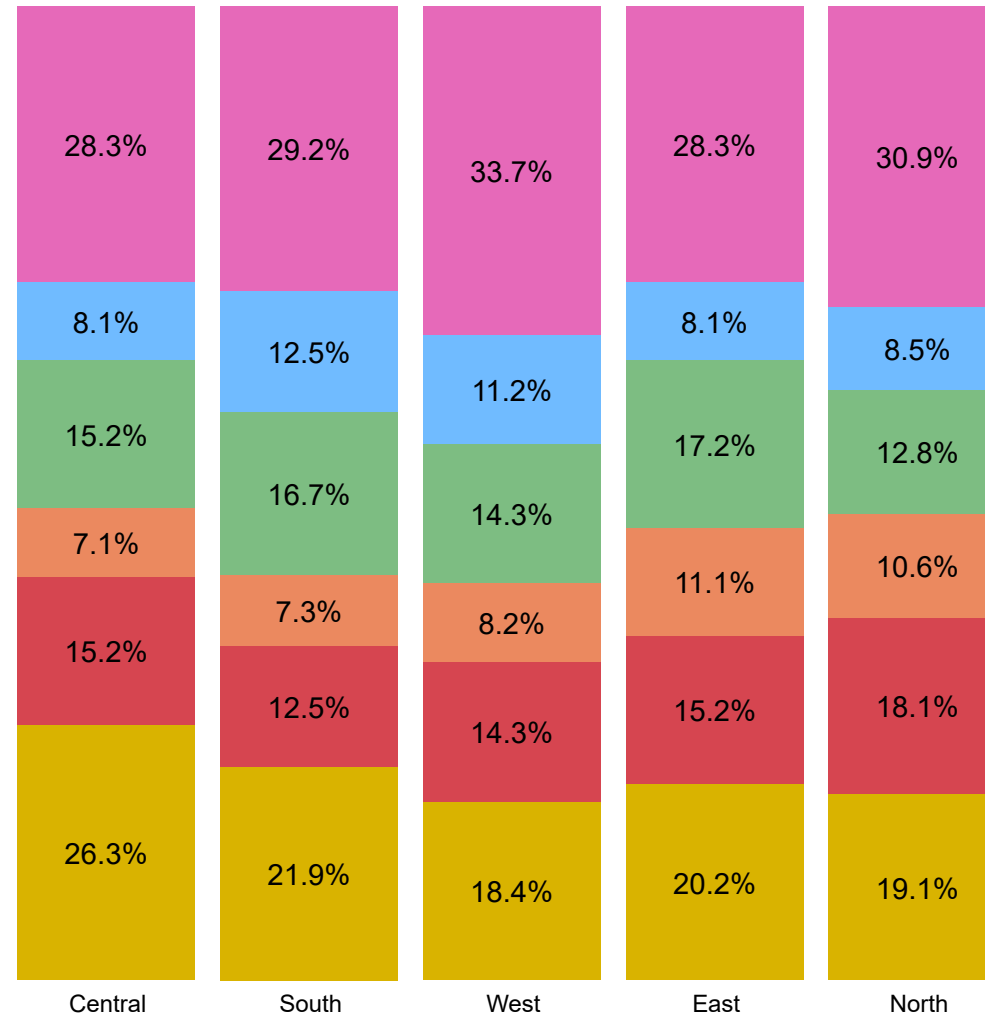

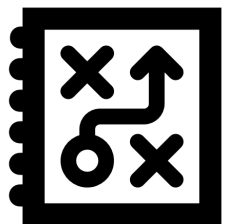


Social Care Referrals by Source (2022/23)

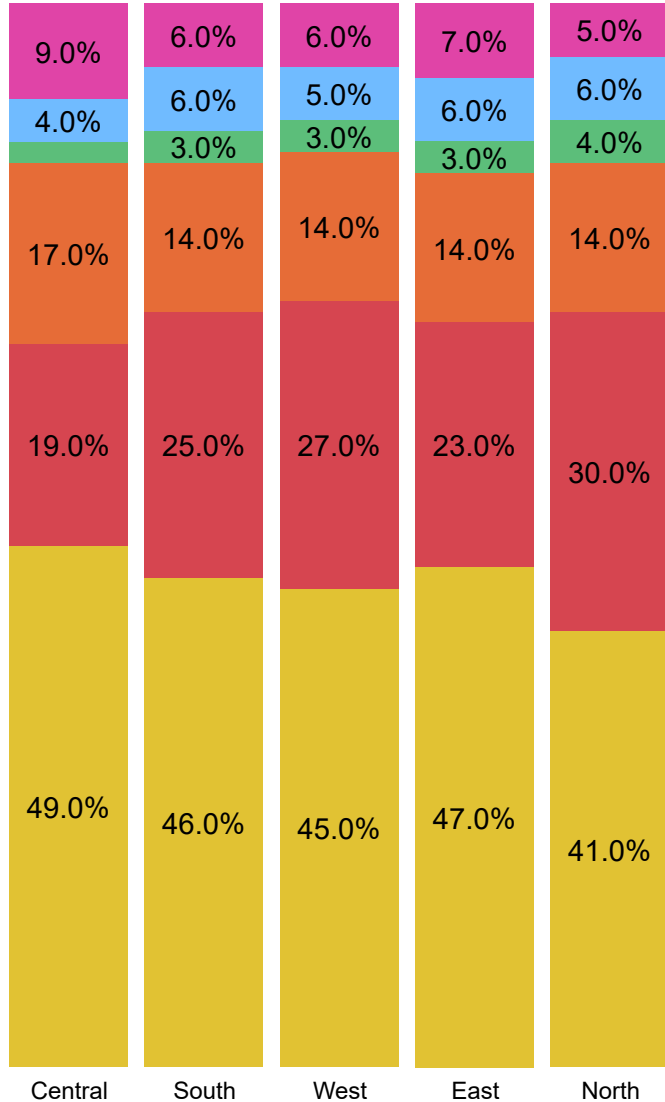

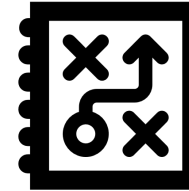

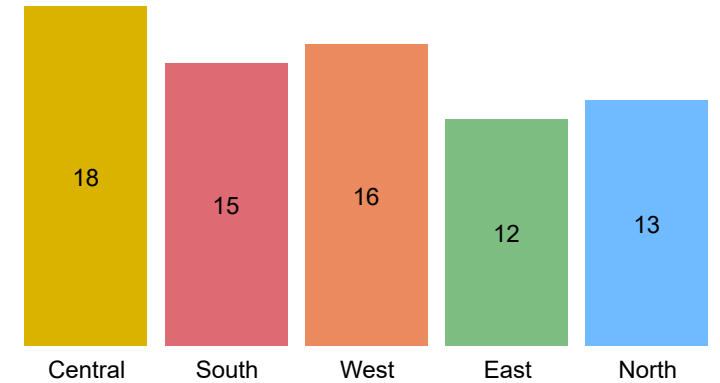

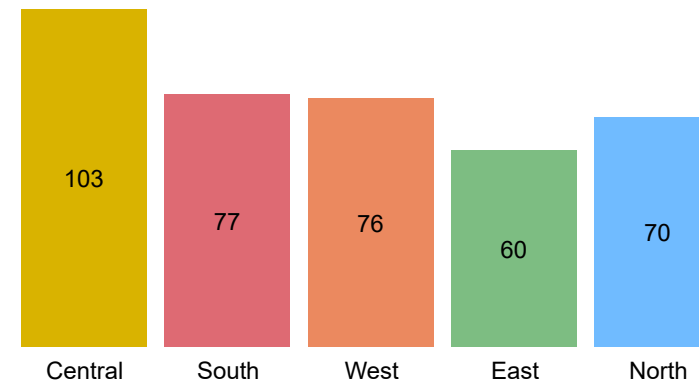


Adult Social Care Community Activity per 1,000 (18+), age-standardised (2022/23)

North District's rate of Social Care referrals is **second lowest** across Oldham.

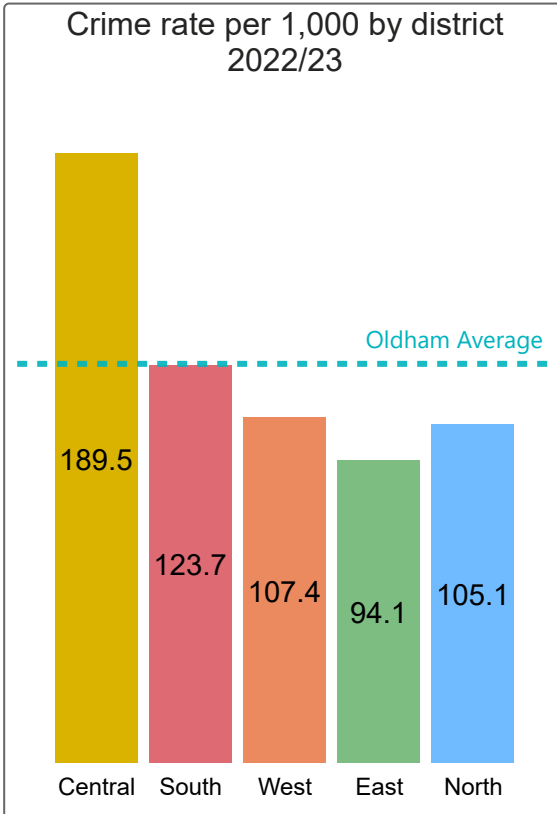

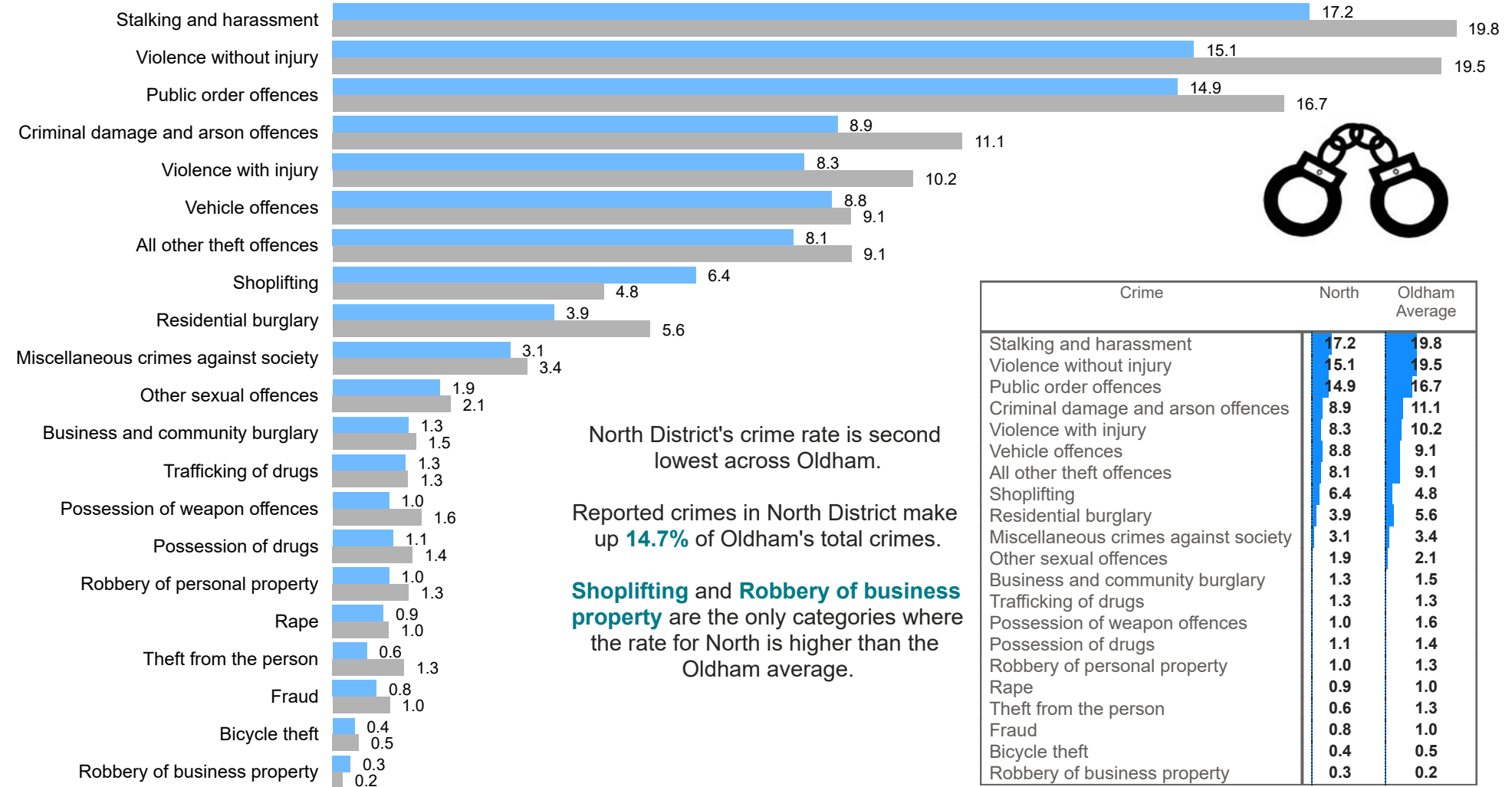
Crime rate per 1,000 by district 2022/23

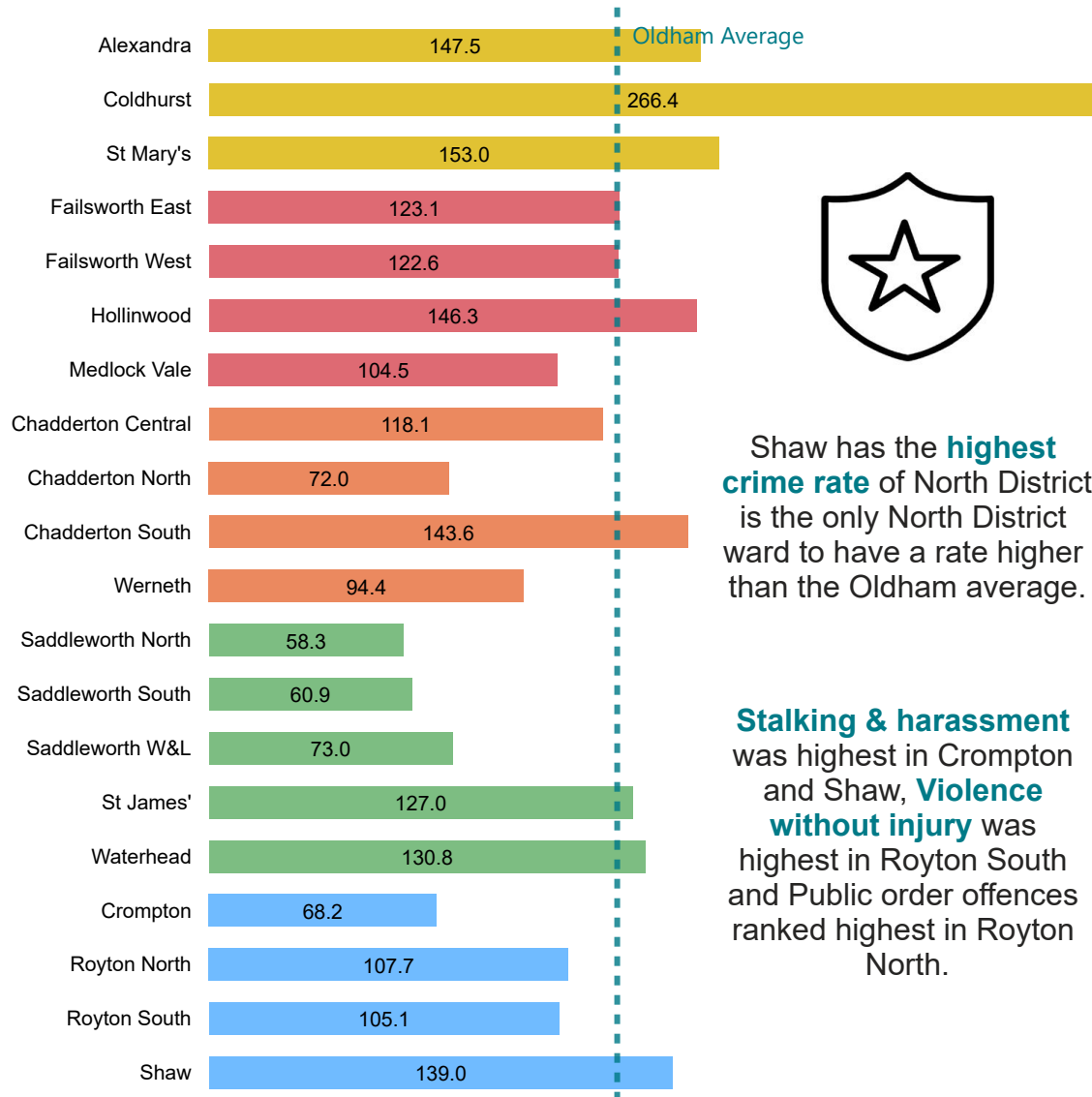

Crime rate per 1,000 by Oldham ward, 2022/23



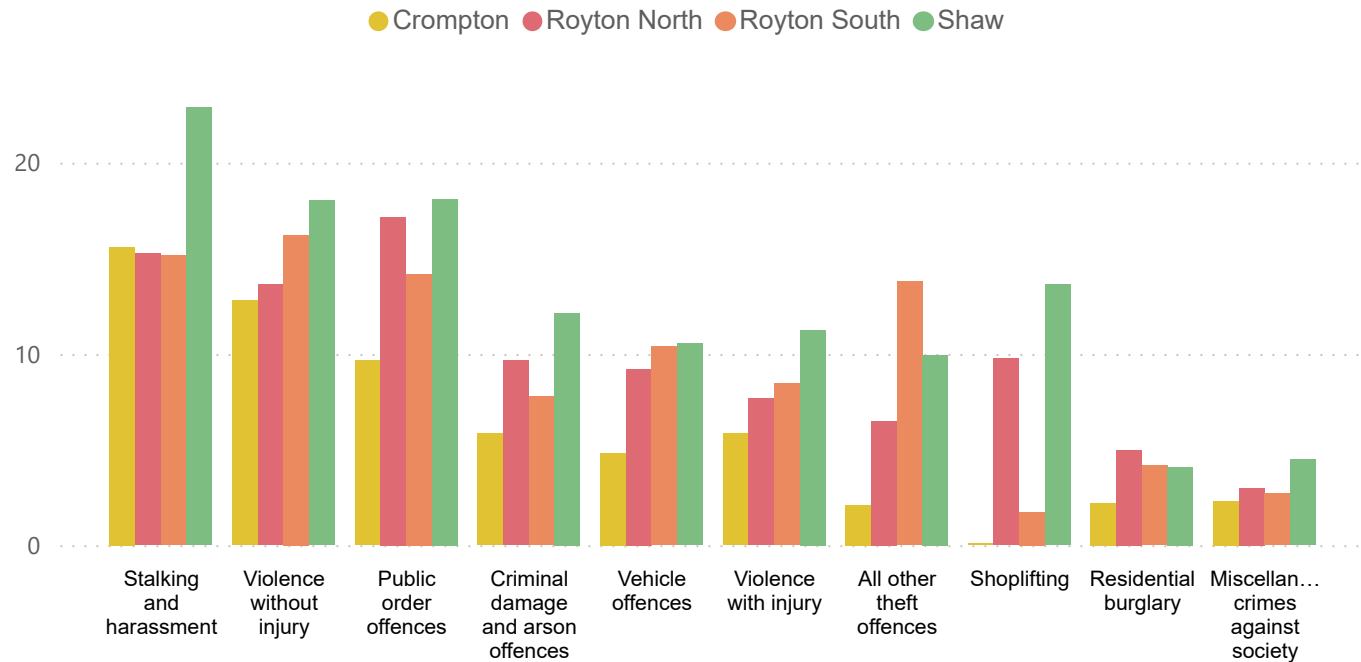
Shaw has the **highest crime rate** of North District is the only North District ward to have a rate higher than the Oldham average.

Stalking & harassment was highest in Crompton and Shaw, **Violence without injury** was highest in Royton South and Public order offences ranked highest in Royton North.
